Revati's cultural experience of living in London mixed with her own Indian heritage has been the source of a very particular language in her work. As an instinctive maker her practice crosses boundaries using photography, paper, paint and found objects producing extraordinary and

engaging forms. Objects may be constructed on a miniature obsessive scale or as arches of colour drawn across a space, pushing the boundaries of a formal sculptural language. The work is both lyrical and engaging and at times its suggested narrative has a wry humour.

Supported by Acme studios and individual donations the award was established in memory of artist and Slade graduate Adrian Carruthers who died in 2001 at the age of 40. Revati Mann is the 7th recipient of the award.

Acme Studios, established by artists in 1972, is a London-based charity which provides affordable studio space, residencies and awards for artists in economic need. Recognised as the leading studio development organisation in England, Acme continues to make a vital contribution to the development of art and of artists' careers.
